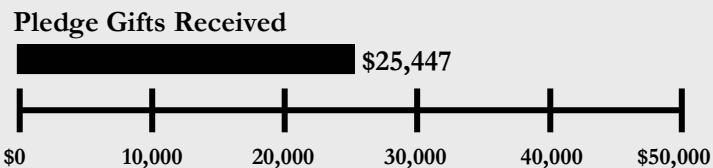

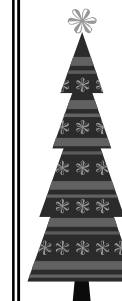


Tree of Sharing
