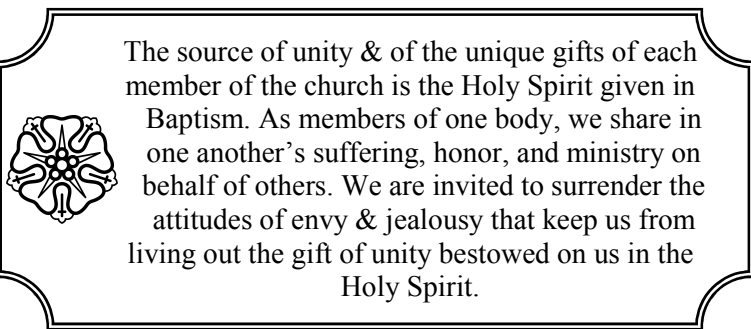

EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

This past week Catholic Relief Services (CRS) began turning a Port-au-Prince golf course into one of the first formal camps for those displaced by the earthquake in Haiti. 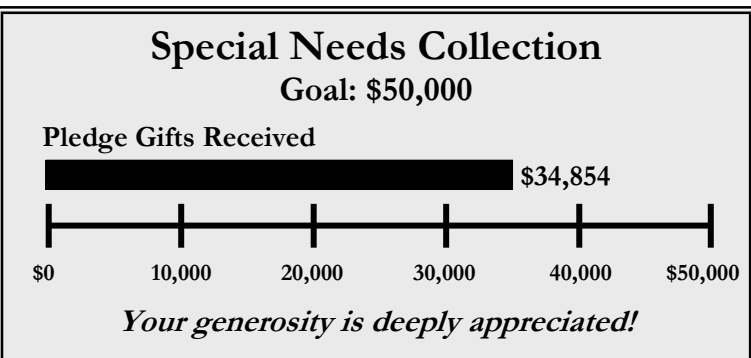

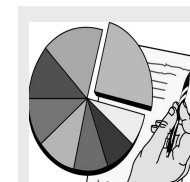
