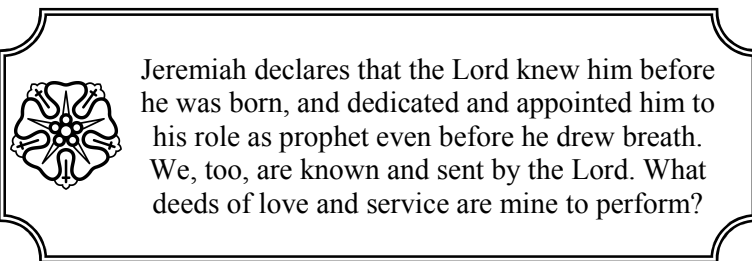

EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

This past week Catholic Relief Services (CRS) began turning a Port-au-Prince golf course into one of the first formal camps for those displaced by the earthquake in Haiti. CRS staff also delivered medical supplies to St. Francois de Sales hospital and helped in getting the heavily damaged hospital up and running. 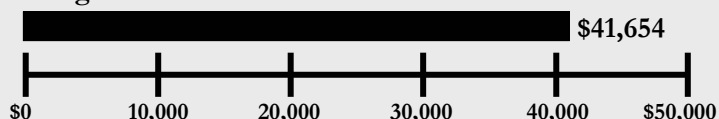
