Junior High

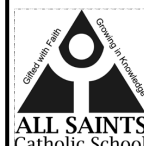
February 13: Junior High Youth Group will meet in the Youth Center from 4 – 6:00pm. Topic for the night is an *Overview of the Bible*.

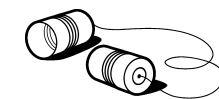
ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL
