Operation Rice Bowl

In southern Egypt, Catholic Relief Services sponsors a Micro-finance Project that helps people start small businesses. One woman began her own home bakery with a loan of \$90.

Babaganoush

1 large eggplant, 1/4 cup lemon juice, 1 Tbs. *tahini, 1 tsp. salt, 2 cloves garlic, 1/2 tsp. ground cumin

Preheat oven to 425 **DEGREES**. Punch holes in the skin of the eggplant with a fork and place it on a baking sheet. Cook for 30-45 minutes, until the eggplant is soft. Let the eggplant cool, then remove the skin and seeds and pat the eggplant dry. Put in blender, add salt, garlic, lemon juice and tahini. Blend until mixture is smooth. Sprinkle with cumin and serve with pita bread.

*Think peanut butter, only made with sesame seeds. Sesame seeds are crushed and placed in salt water where the bran sinks and the kernels float. The kernels are skimmed off the surface, toasted and then ground to produce an oily paste. There are two types of tahini, light and dark and the light is considered to have both the best flavor and texture.
