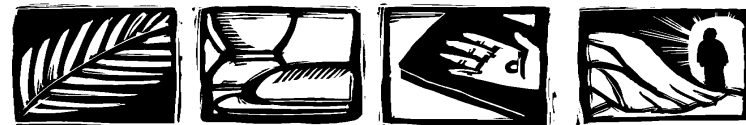

Operation Rice Bowl

One of the central tenets of Catholic Social Teaching is the Option for the Poor. As a community of faith, we have the obligation to reach out to those most in need.

The Gospel specifically calls us to take action on behalf of the most vulnerable members of society. In the western part of the Honduras, a favorite meal of plantain turnovers is enjoyed by families who are aided by Catholic Relief Services. The recipe from their country follows:

3 plantains (soft to the touch) 1/2 cup cooked black beans
1/4 cup of sugar 2/3 cup vegetable oil
1/2 Tbsp cinnamon

Wash and cut plantains into three pieces. Boil until soft, drain and mash plantains. Place beans in a blender until you have a soft puree. Fry beans with a little bit of oil and add the sugar and cinnamon. Heat remaining oil in another frying pan, add plantain mixture, 1 Tbsp at a time, and spread with a fork into a shape of a small pancake. Fry 3 minutes. Place 1 tsp. fried beans on each pancake and fold shaping into a turnover. Fry for 3 minutes on each side until brown.
