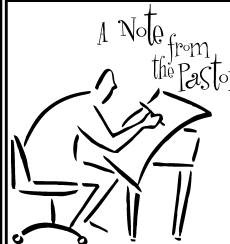

A Note from the Pastor
The "Paschal Fast" begins on Good Friday and continues until the celebration of the Vigil on Holy Saturday. These are days of fast from food and abstinence from meat. The fasting and abstinence of these days are different in character from the usual Fridays of Lent. On those days our actions are undertaken with a spirit of penitence. During the Paschal Fast, even though we remember the death of the Lord with sorrow, on these days we fast and abstain in joyful anticipation of the Feast of Easter.

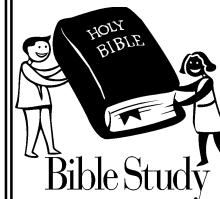
