 Today's reading from Acts continues an account of Peter's attempts to convince fellow Israelites that the Jesus condemned and executed by Rome has been raised by God. To many Israelites, the preacher from Nazareth who often ignored their religious laws could not possibly have been God's Messiah, and his Crucifixion proved it. Few, if any, among the Jewish people expected a Messiah like Jesus. He gathered no armies, built no earthly empire and killed no enemy; rather, the Anointed One came as a shepherd! When have you seen God act in unpredictable and surprising way for your benefit?
