Faithful in his oneness with God, the vine grower, Jesus, finally completes God's plan for a chosen people. Similarly, the very life and fruitfulness of believers completely depends upon their oneness with Jesus.

For John, in today's gospel, the believer's union with Jesus participates in Jesus' own oneness with God. Later in the Last Supper discourse, Jesus crystallizes this crucial point: as the Father is in Jesus, and Jesus is in the Father, so the disciple must live in Jesus and Jesus in the disciple (John 17:20-23). Only in this manner can the believer bear the good fruit of Resurrection life; life in God through Jesus.

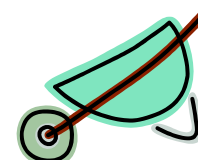
