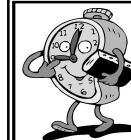

Collection for the Catholic Church in the United States

The Collection for the Catholic Church in the United States will be taken up on the weekend of **May 16th-17th, 2009** in all parishes throughout the Diocese of Spokane. This collection, which supports Black & Native American Missions, Catholic Campaign for Human Development, among others, is one of the four (4) annual collections authorized by Bishop Skylstad when he reorganized the diocesan collections in January 1999. The other three collections are the World Missions Collection, Catholic Charities Christmas Collection and the Annual Catholic Appeal.
