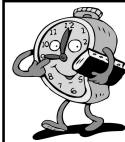

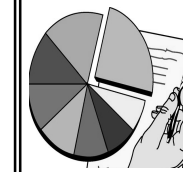

Cost: \$180 per person. \$50 nonrefundable deposit

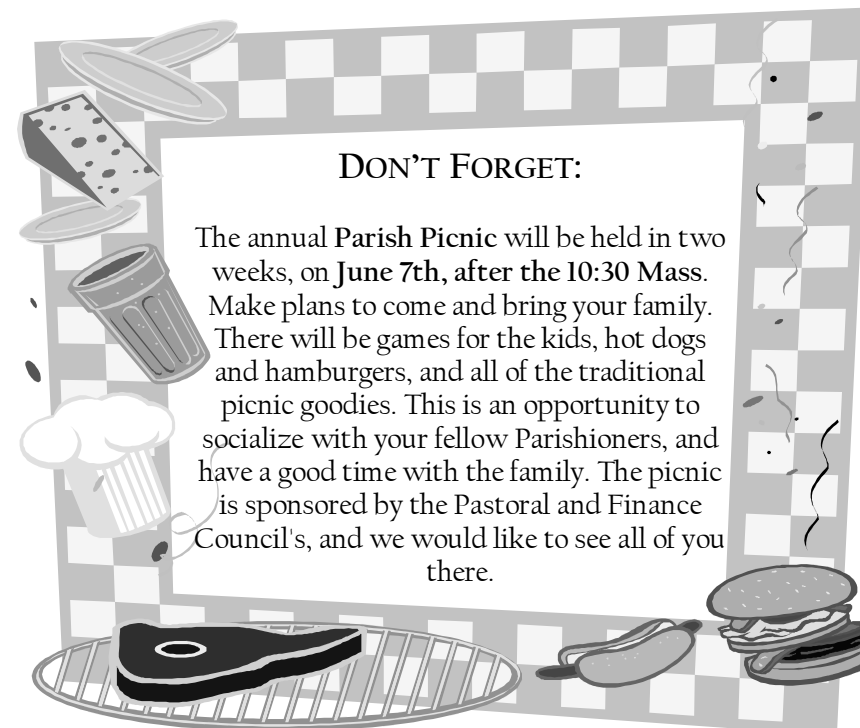
