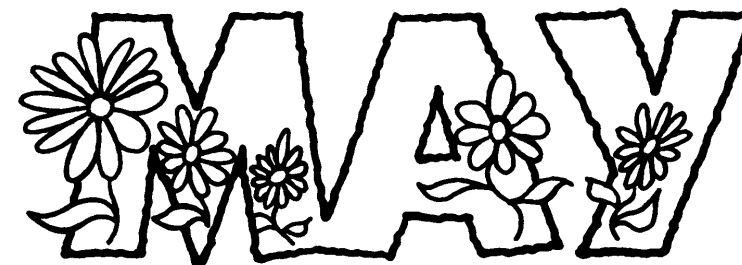
ALL SAINTS NEWS

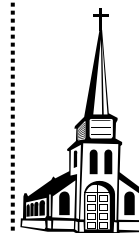


COUNCIL NOMINATIONS
