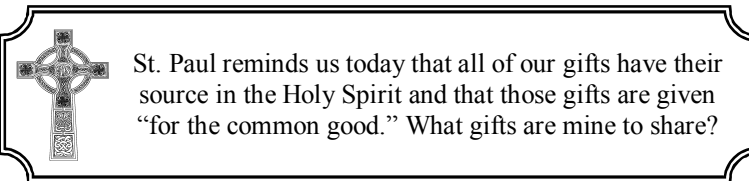

First Friday Adoration

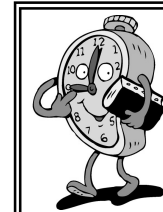
Continuous prayer before the Blessed Sacrament takes place in the church on First Fridays starting at 9:00 am and ending with Benediction at 4:00 pm.

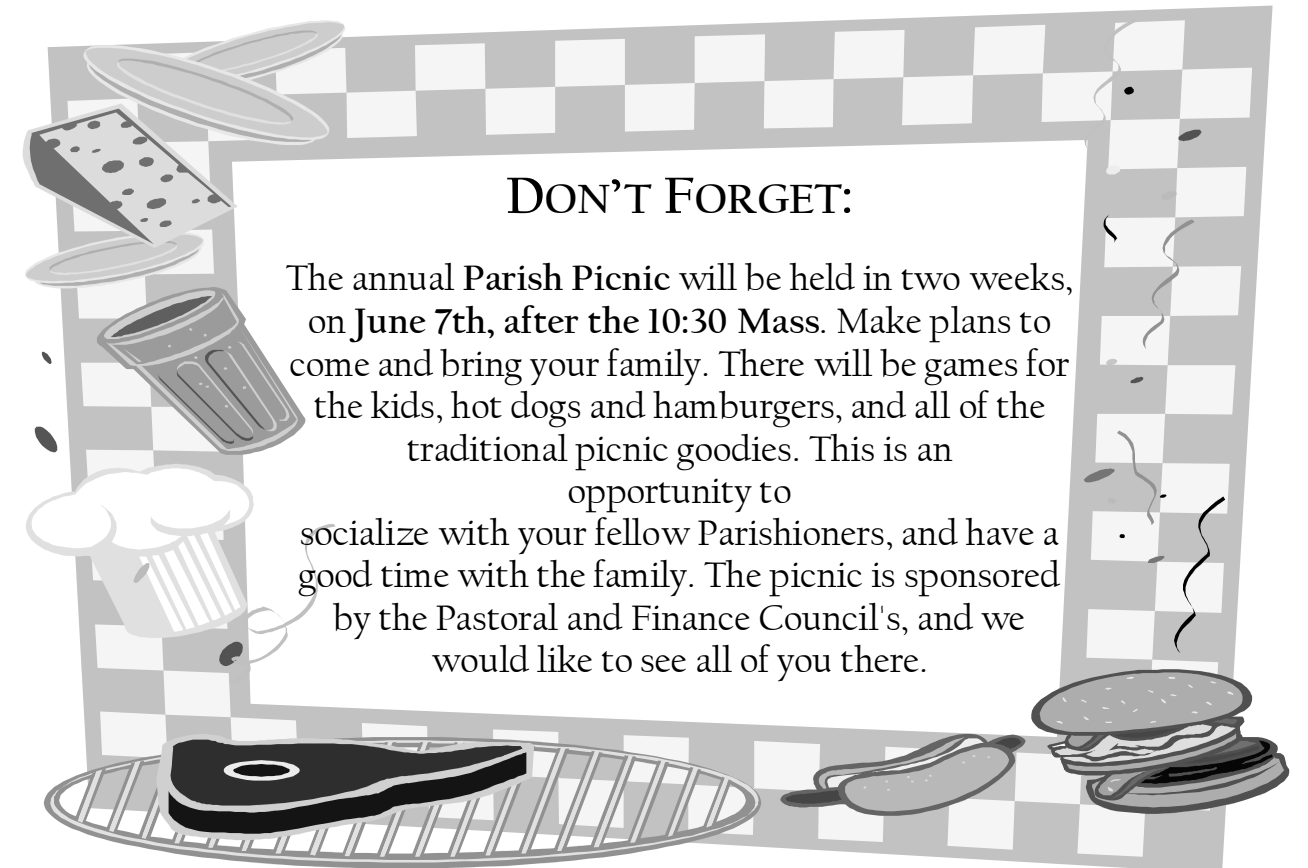
Summer Office Hours
