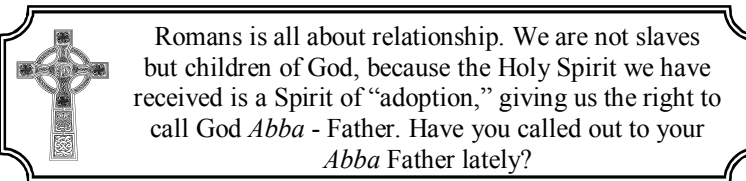

Thank you to all who have gifted their support for our diocesan Church through the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA).

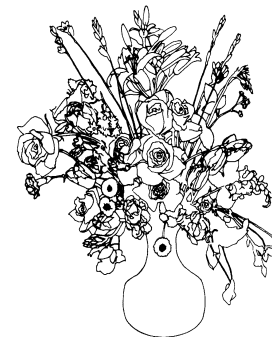
Thus far, 251 households have pledged \$74,256 to our parish goal of \$84,900. These households constitute 37% of our parish families.
