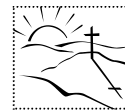

Wednesday Night in the Gardens continues from June 13 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. (Weather Permitting)

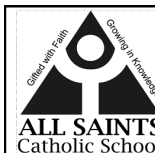
