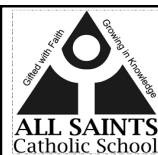
Garden for the Poor

Mother Mentors Needed

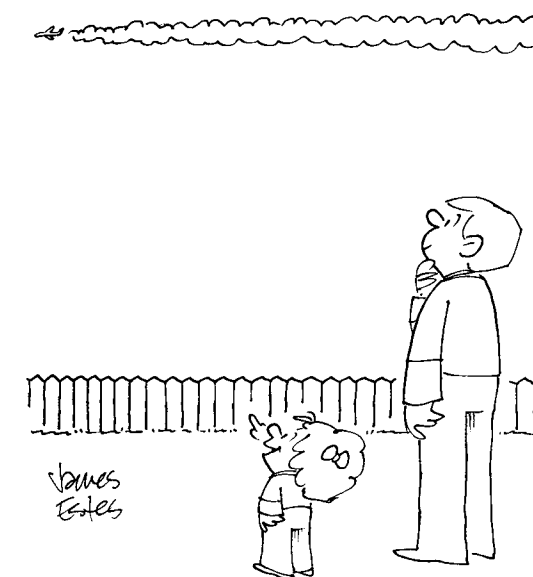
