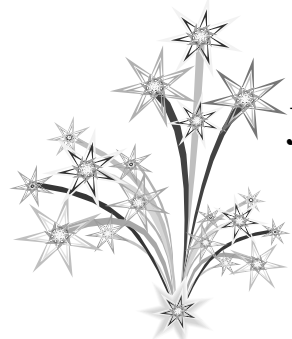

IGNATIAN RETREAT

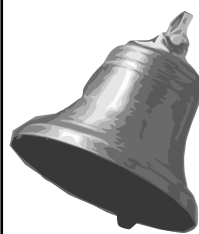
JULY 10-16, 2011
