

With this increase, there will be a total of fourteen volunteers, necessitating the acquisition of a new house, which Catholic Charities is facilitating. However, this house, at 1006 E Augusta, is unfurnished. Consequently, we are appealing to parishioners for furniture and other household items.

Items Needed

Bedrooms:	6 beds (mattresses, box springs, sheets/blankets), 6 dressers, 6 lamps
Living Room:	couches & arm chairs
Dining Room:	table, 6-7 chairs
Kitchen:	plates, bowls, silverware & cutting utensils, glasses/cups/mugs, saucepans, frying pans, cookie sheets, baking dishes, colander, Tupperware with lids, trash bags, hand towels, dish rack, crock pot
Laundry Room:	laundry baskets, clothes pins, clothesline, laundry detergent
Bathroom:	shower curtains, toilet paper
Miscellaneous:	area rugs, telephone & answering machine, trash cans, scissors, pens, paper, first aid kit, coat hangers
