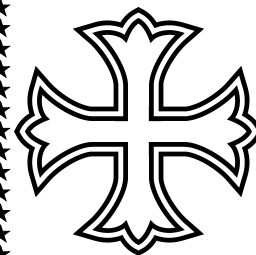
### GARDEN FOR THE POOR

### PARISH LIBRARY

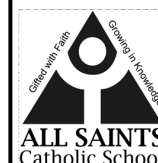

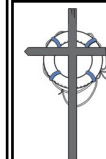
