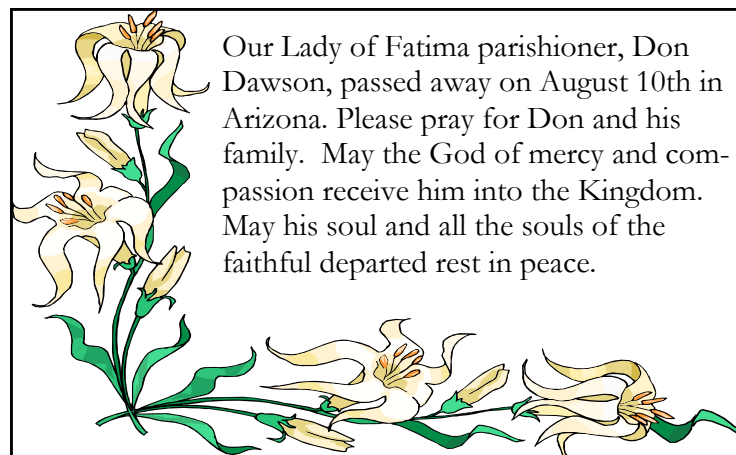
Garden for the Poor - New
