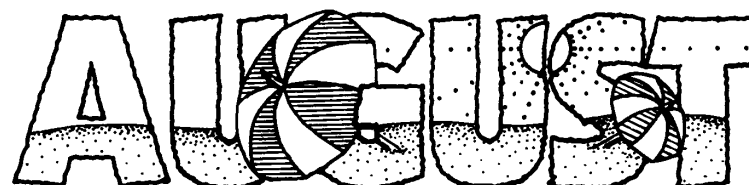

MASS STIPENDS and OFFERINGS for the ADMINISTRATION of SACRAMENTS

Bishop Skylstad, acting on recommendations from the Presbyteral Council, has approved several changes in compensation policy at the parish level. The first is that an appropriate stipend for a *Mass Card* is \$10. Our Lady of Fatima effected this change on July 14, 2008.

In addition, the Council also recommended and the Bishop approved, that the donation to the parish at the time of a funeral, wedding or baptism should reflect the real economic costs and service supported by the parish community. While there is never a charge for these services, the suggested stipends for parishioners are: \$75 for a Baptism; \$200 for a funeral; and \$300 for a wedding or 10% of the family expenditure for the cost of the wedding.
