

The Gospel reading for today concludes Jesus' "Bread of Life" discourse that we have been hearing over the past three Sundays. Now that Jesus has revealed his true identity, the crowds are faced with

the clear choice: accept or reject Jesus. For discipleship to be authentic, it must be a free choice. At this point, some in the crowd are convinced by Jesus' words, but many others find them difficult to accept and are resistant, even hostile to Jesus....

Jesus turns to the Twelve and asks, "Do you also want to leave?" Jesus' question here to the Twelve is an eternal question for all who claim to be Christian. Simon Peter's response to Jesus is the mark of true and authentic discipleship: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."


