Sr. Mary Garvin - Spiritual Exercises for Daily Life

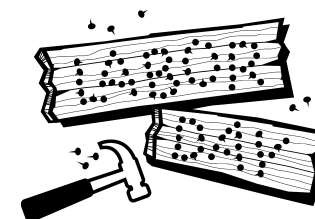
