Fr. Steve Dublinski, Vicar General and a few of his friends will be riding 100 miles to raise funds for Bishop White Seminary Foundation. This year Bishop White Seminary has received a matching grant from the Extension Society for up to \$50,000 for new foundation money raised before the end of this year. So far we have raised \$20,000. The goal is to raise the remaining \$30,000 through donations during the Tour de la Diócesis.
