BLOOD DRIVE... *THIS SUNDAY*

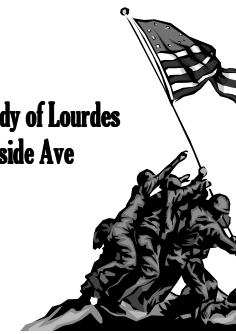
