**Catholic Charities Fair Trade Sale: Nov. 17/18**

Scott Cooper, of Catholic Charities, will be here next week in the parish hall after

masses for a Fair Trade Sale. This will include items from Catholic Relief Services' Work of Human Hands fair trade program catalog, as well as fair trade chocolates from a couple of different sources. Also, Nectar of Life, a local fair trade coffee company that is the only CRS-registered coffee roaster in Eastern Washington (meaning they are 100% fair trade and a portion of their proceeds benefit CRS' coffee growers programs in Central America) will be here. Likii Tender Hearts, a non-profit fair trade artisan group begun by a Kenyan woman who is a parishioner at St. John Vianney, will have items crafted by the people in Liki Village, Kenya. Her proceeds support people living with HIV/AIDS in her native region of Kenya.
