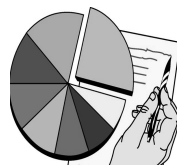

The Concern group will meet this Thursday, November 19th, at 10am in the Gathering Place. Please join us.

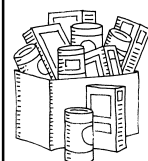

ANNUAL COMMUNITY THANKSGIVING DINNER



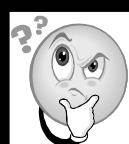
