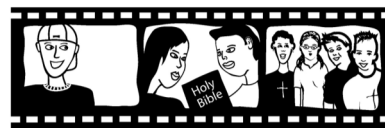

YOUTH MINISTRY

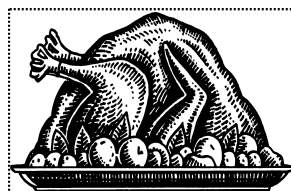
