


## 50th Anniversary Report

Cathedral of Our Lady of Lourdes December 18, 2009 at 7:00 pm



The parade of Holy Pilgrims (that is you) stops at a designated door of the church to sing a traditional litany by which the Holy Family requests shelter for the night and those waiting behind the closed door turn them away. They proceed to a second door where the scene is repeated. At the third stop the pilgrims are told that while there is no room in the *posada* (inn), they are welcome to take refuge in the stable. The doors are flung open and all are invited to enter.
