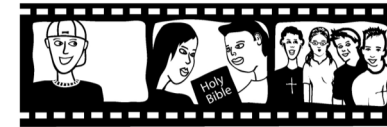

There will be Christmas goodies, activities, and of course, a visit from jolly old St. Nick himself.



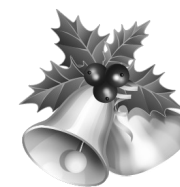
YOUTH MINISTRY
